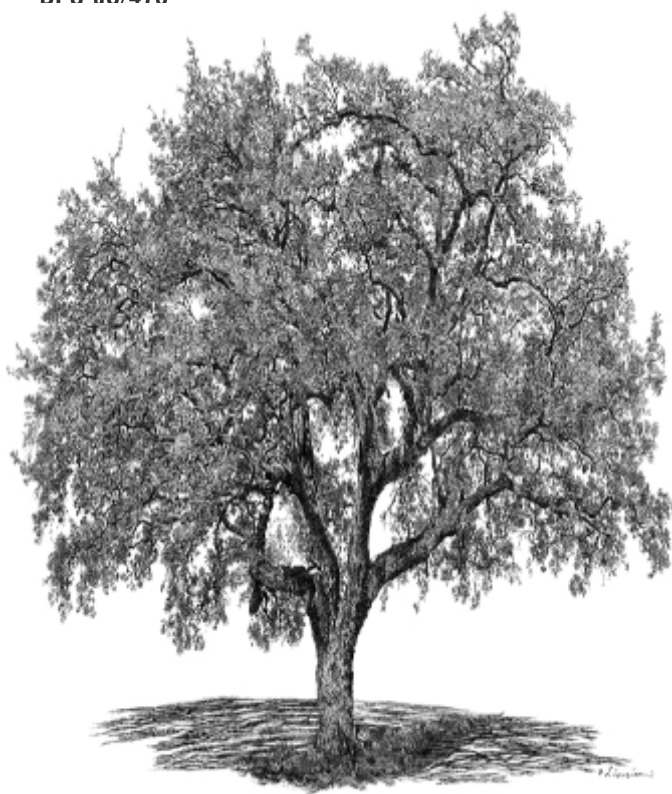
## Importance of Trees

In 1893 he participated in the Parliament of Religions in Chicago. There he delivered a historic speech on Vedantic Hinduism and left a deep impression on everyone. He left for his heavenly abode on 4th July 1902. Now his disciples are found all over the world.

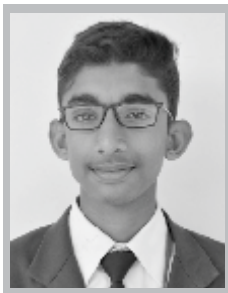
In many ways a lot of our impression about the world around us is formed by what we see on television, it is like a window. Now a question must arise as to how does it influence us?
