In conclusion, it is said that "we (DPS- JC family) shall overcome" because we never compromise with quality rather we believe in commitment and hard work in grim situations.








ONLINE CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAM



It was a novice experience that taught us how a programme can be successfully compiled and completed in the situation of constant instability due to the prevailing pandemic.


GRAND PARENT'S DAY
