12th January, 2022


"Take risk in your life, if you win you may lead...if you lose you may guide."

The event was organised by "Child Abuse and Women Harassment Committee". In which the event was hosted by Mr. Aadesh Prajapati.





A presentation was given by Mr. Ajay Soni on " Women Empowerment" And the roles and achievements of our country's daughters.


Our Chief Guest also elaborated that why the education is necessary for all girls to make the society and country strong.


are given to kids from all over India for their meritorious acts of bravery.
